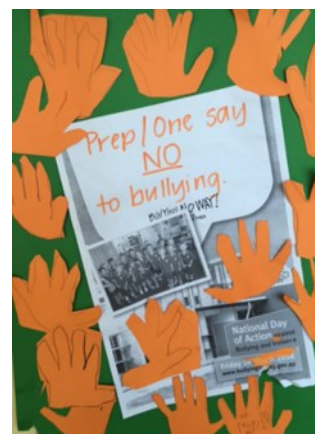


### BULLYING. NO WAY!
